BARMERA SHACKS

Want to get away these school holidays?

Why not try the Barmera Shacks.?

Two fully self-contained shacks are available. Each shack sleeps up to 6 people.

The Riverland area has a number of attractions that are sure to suit everyone’s needs. Here are some of the attractions available.

The shacks were renovated in 2000 and are self-contained. Each shack can accommodate a family of up to six people. They each consist of:

- ◆ Two bedrooms (one with double bed, the other with two bunks),
- ◆ Full kitchen facilities including all cutlery, crockery and cooking utensils, microwave, oven, fridge etc,
- ◆ Small lounge/dining with TV,
- ◆ Reverse Cycle air conditioning,
- ◆ Separate toilet/shower block (one bathroom for each shack),
- ◆ Laundry with automatic washing machine and ironing facilities,
- ◆ Gas BBQ,
- ◆ Outdoor table and chairs, and
- ◆ Canoes (life jackets available through the Welfare Store).

Barmera is one of the most popular aquatic playgrounds in South Australia. Situated in the heart of the Riverland, Barmera is a beautiful town located on the shores of Lake Bonney - a lake renowned for its sunsets. Lake Bonney is fresh water, fed from the Murray River through the Chambers Creek wetlands. Because the lake is shallow and has a sandy bottom, it is ideal for swimming, sailing, windsurfing, canoeing, kayaking, skiing, jet skiing, boating and fishing. The lake also abounds with bird life.

- ◆ The towns of Berri, Renmark, Loxton and Waikerie are all located within a half-hour’s drive of Barmera.

THE GAME

Originally released in 2006, Company of Heroes set a new benchmark in the Real Time Strategy Genre: Unparalleled detail make this game easy on the eye. Challenging Campaigns and a good variety in multiplayer options keep this game going strong after four years. After two expansions ("Opposing Fronts" and "Tales of Valor"), the game has evolved into a must-have for every RTS fan. The Campaigns and units are drawn from the Battles fought on the European Western Front in 1944.

American Forces:

The American forces are easy to play thanks to a simple upgrade path and straightforward tactics and units. Emphasis is placed on quantity rather than quality in their squads, and armor are more successful in numbers making this faction difficult to beat once established. The sub-factions are:



Airborne: Paratroopers, air-dropped AT guns and Air support,

Infantry: Anti-tank Rangers and long-range howitzer artillery

Armour: Advanced vehicle tactics, unique Pershing tanks and Calliope rocket artillery

British Forces

British forces stand out as it is the only faction with a mobile construction building and a vast array of defensive emplacements.

Royal Engineers – Stronger Tanks and improved defensive emplacements

Royal Artillery – Elite forces with advanced capabilities and mobile artillery pieces

Royal Commandos – Behind-enemy-lines troop drops make this faction unpredictable

Wehrmacht

The German army of 1944, is complex and versatile. It has more unit types than any other faction and as a result requires careful planning depending on the opposition's tactics as the units are small and very specialised. The main advantage of this side is the fact that unit veterancy can be purchased (for a very high cost) making all units more powerful right off the production line. This makes for a very capable end-game force. The Wehrmacht sub factions are:

Defensive: The 88-AT gun, reinforcements from bunkers and artillery for a slow victory

Blitzkrieg: Decisive support abilities, Camouflaged infantry, tracked howitzer and Tiger tanks

Terror: Anti-infantry artillery, forced retreat, one King tiger tank and the devastating V1



Panzer Elite:

This faction is very different from the Wehrmacht as it allows for maximum customisation of units. The upgrade path of this faction is complex but can be matched to the particular map and enemy tactics. Choosing veterancy bonuses (defensive or offensive) and the ability to equip the basic infantry with three types of weapons makes this a very good early-game force. It relies on mobility and speed to crush the enemy as there are no emplacements available, however the small squad sizes require careful management of reinforcements and retreat paths. The factions are diverse:

Luftwaffe – Panzer Elite faction with emplacements, plus strong support abilities and units

Tank Destroyer – Powerful aggressive force, strong tanks and anti-tank abilities

Scorched Earth – A defensive strategy of territory denial and long-range mobile artillery

SINGLE PLAYER

Invasion of Normandy

Play as American Forces through the longest Campaign from The Normandy Landings through 16 missions. This campaign reminds one of "Saving Private Ryan" and "Band of Brothers".

Operation Market Garden

As the Panzer Elite stationed in the Netherlands, fight the attacking British and American Paratroopers over eight battles, culminating in "The Bridge Too Far" at Arnhem.

Liberation of Caen

Follow the British contingent from D-Day and secure Caen after nine exhausting battles.

Tiger Ace

The first of three short campaigns; The elite Tiger tank crew fights its way from early defeat to glorious victory by utilising their advanced abilities gained through experience.

Causeway



The heroism of the Paratroopers in the early stages of the Allied invasion in 1944 are portrayed here, focussing on one hero that singlehandedly turned the tide of an entire battle.

Falaise Pocket

This short campaign is built around the defensive struggle to save your fellow soldier's lives to fight another day. Play as the scattered German Army retreating from the encircled Falaise Pocket.



MULTIPLAYER AND SKIRMISH

The multiplayer of the game is varied, with capture-the-flag, survival and territory domination game modes there is great variety with much depth. Destructible terrain and provision for diverse strategies give this game endless replayability. Both on-line and LAN multiplayer is enabled and a strong mod community has created hundreds of maps and scenarios to grow this great RTS game.

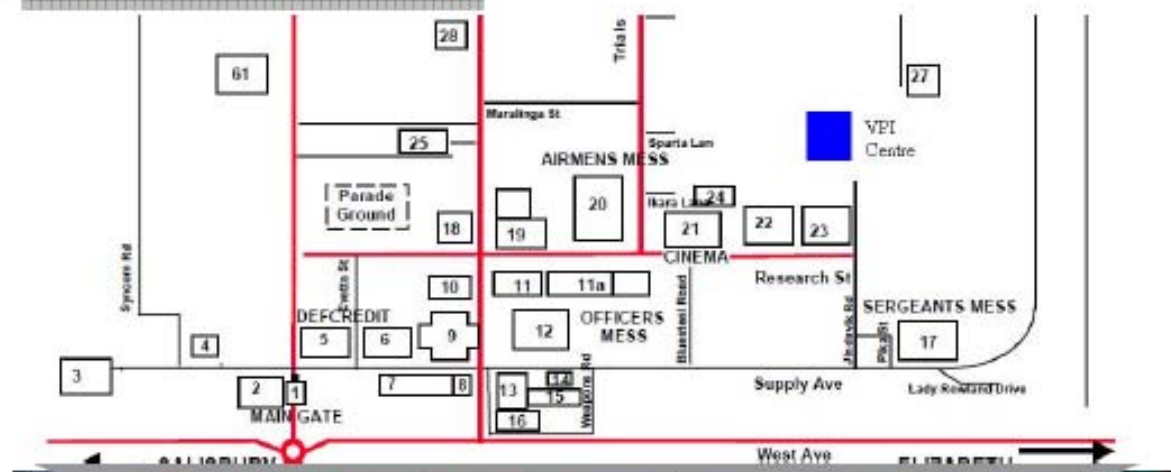

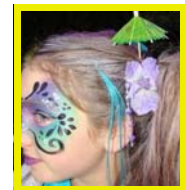
